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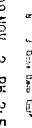

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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

In Compliance with Chapter 617, F.S., (Not for Profit)

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SECRETARY OF STATE TALLAHASSEE, FLORIDA

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the corporation shall be:

ARTICLE II PRINCIPAL OFFICE

ARTICLE III PURPOSE

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is:

The purpose of the corporation is to contribute toward the advancement of education and science, to give relief to the poor, and to lessen burdens of the government. It is to promote energy conservation and renewable energy technologies, and to facilitate sustainable energy solutions for enhancements in education, policy, health, and agriculture. Said corporation is organized exclusively for educational, scientific, and charitable purposes; including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE IV MANNER OF ELECTION

The manner in which the directors are elected or appointed:

The current board members will nominate the nominees in the December Board Meeting prior to the Annual Meeting, which is to be held in January of each year. Those nominees will be voted on by the current board members via a closed ballot at the Annual Meeting, and will be counted by the Secretary and Treasurer. The Secretary will announce the results.

ARTICLE VIII POWERS OF THE CORPORATION

The undersigned are citizens of the United States, to form a Non Profit Corporation under the Non-Profit Corporation Law of Florida, do hereby certify desiring: First: The name of the Corporation shall be National Renewable Energy Educational Center, Inc.

Second: The place in this state where the principal office of the Corporation is to be located is the City of Vero Beach, Indian River County, Florida, 32960.

ARTICLE IX LIMITATIONS OF THE CORPORATION

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes.

ARTICLE X DISSOLUTION

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue

Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

Having been named as registered agent to accept service of process for the above stated corporation at the place designated in this certificate, I am familiar with and accept the appointment as registered agent and agree to act in this capacity.
