## **ARTICLE I (Name)**

The name of the organization shall be Help Bainet Foundation, Inc

#### ARTICLE II (Office)

The initial principal address of the organization shall be 1265 Rosegate Blvd, Riviera Beach fl 33404

The mailing address shall be P.O. Box 243091, Boynton Beach FL 33424

#### **ARTICLE III (Purpose/Mission)**

Help Bainet Foundation is a registered non-profit organization based in the state of Florida, with an exclusive charitable mission to aid the poor and underprivileged men, women and children of Bainet, Haiti

#### Purpose:

The deprived town of Bainet and its surrounding rural areas are increasingly enduring malnutrition, community deterioration, unemployment, Health - Sanitation tribulations, and illiteracy.

#### Mission/Objectives:

HBF will focus on creating programs that will provide relief to the poor, initiate revitalization projects that will develop employment opportunities and reduce community deterioration, improve illiteracy, combating health and sanitation issues and educate to reduce future crisis.

- [x] Help Bainet Foundation is organized exclusively for charitable mission
- [x] No part of the net earnings of the organization shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to it's members, trustees, officers or other private persons, except that the organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of section 501(c) (3) purposes. No Substantial part of the activities of the organization shall be carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the organization shall not participate in, intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.
- [x] Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding

section of any future federal tax code or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the Corresponding section of any future federal code.

[x] Upon the Dissolution f this corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the Federal Government, or to a state of local government, for public purpose.

# **ARTICLE IV (Election)**

The management of all the affairs, property, and interests of the organization shall be vested in a Board of Governors consisting of Eighteen (18) member's total. The Board of Governors general elections are held every two years during the month of November. The Executive Board of Governors positions (6) are elected by the affirmative vote of a majority of a public quorum. The Council Board (12) of Governors shall be appointed by the affirmative vote of majority of the elected Executive Board of Governors. The elected Board of Governors shall assume position of office beginning January 1<sup>st</sup> and ending December 31st for a term of two years pursuant to the bylaws.

#### **ARTICLE V (Initial Board of Governors/Directors**

The incorporators hereby selected a temporary board of 25 members to conduct the initial elections of the Board of Governors. The initial Executive Board of Governors (6) were elected by an affirmative vote of a majority of the temporary board. The initial Council Board (10) of Governors were appointed by the affirmative vote of the elected Executive Board of Governors. The initial Board of Governors are to serve for a term of two years until their successors are chosen pursuant to the bylaws. The persons chosen as the initial board of Governors are as follows:
