ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the corporation is THE LEARNING CENTER OF PLANT CITY AT THE FIRST PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH OF PLANT CITY, FLORIDA, INC. (the "Corporation"), and the same is hereby organized by the undersigned to form a nonprofit corporation under the Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act, Fla. Stat. § 617.01011, et seq.

ARTICLE II - DURATION

The term of existence of the Corporation is perpetual, and the Corporation's existence will commence on the filing of these Articles by the Secretary of State.

ARTICLE III - NON PROFIT PURPOSES AND POWERS

The purposes for which the Corporation is organized and the general nature of the business and operation of the Corporation are:

(a) Exclusively for literary and educational purposes, including for such purposes, being and dealing with other organizations that qualify as exempt

organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code");

- (b) To operate as a learning center for young children;
- (c) To act as liaison between the children and other community organizations, including educational organizations, to promote the literary and educational purposes of the Corporation;
- (d) To engage in any lawful purpose or purposes not for pecuniary profit, subject to the above;
- To see that no part of the net earnings of the inure to the benefit of, Corporation shall distributable to, its directors, trustees, members, officers, or other private persons, except that Corporation shall be authorized and empowered reasonable compensation for services rendered, and to make distributions in furtherance of payments and the Corporation's purposes. No substantial part of activities of the Corporation shall be carrying on of otherwise attempting to influence propaganda, or legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provisions of these Articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on:

- (1) by a Corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code; or
- (2) by a Corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Code (or the corresponding provision of any future revision of the United States Internal Revenue Law);
- (3) by a Corporation, gifts to which are deductible for federal gift tax purposes under Section 2522(a)(2) of the Code; or
- (4) by a Corporation, testamentary dispositions to which are deductible for federal estate tax purposes under Section 2055(a) of the Code.
- (f) To conduct programs and activities; raise funds; request and receive grants, gifts and bequests of money; acquire, receive, hold, invest and administer, in its own name, securities, funds, objects of value, or other property, real or personal, and make expenditures to or for the direct or indirect benefit of the Corporation or its or other charitable purposes; and
- (g) If the Corporation shall be or become a private foundation as such term is defined by Section 509 of the Code, then the Corporation shall be required to distribute its income for each taxable year to such time and such manner as not to subject it to tax under Section 4942 of the Code, and the Corporation shall be prohibited from engaging in any act of self-dealing (as defined in I.R.C. § 4941(d)), from making any investments in such manner to

subject the Corporation to tax under Section 4944 of the Code, and from making any taxable expenditures (as defined in I.R.C. § 4945(d)). The statutory references in this paragraph are to the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, and the regulations thereunder, as they now exist and may hereafter be amended from time to time.

ARTICLE IV - ADDRESS

ARTICLE VII - MEMBERSHIP

The Board of Directors shall constitute the Membership of the Corporation. Members of the Corporation shall constitute all directors sitting as the duly elected and/or appointed Board of Directors, in accordance with the By-laws of the Corporation. Members are subject to approval, acceptance and dismissal by the Board of Directors. No stock shall be issued.

ARTICLE VIII - CONDUCT OF CORPORATE AFFAIRS

The business, operations, and affairs of the Corporation will be conducted in the following manner:

Board of Directors: The Board of Directors shall have all corporate authority, management authority, and supervisory authority over the officers of the Corporation. The initial Board of Directors shall serve in accordance with the By-laws until the Annual Meeting of Members, at which time directors will be elected in accordance with the By-laws. The Board of Directors shall appoint officers and delegate authority, as is necessary, to operate the business and affairs of the Corporation in accordance with the By-laws of the Corporation.

There shall be at least seven (7), but no more than eleven (11), Members of the Board of Directors. At all times a majority of the Members of the Board of Directors shall be members of The First Presbyterian Church of Plant City, Florida, Inc. ("FPCPC"). ARTICLE X - DISSOLUTION

The Board of Directors alone has the power to determine to Upon the dissolution of the dissolve this Corporation. Corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provisions for the payment of all the liabilities of the Corporation, dispose of all of the assets Corporation exclusively to the FPCPC or the Presbytery of Tampa Bay, Inc. If such organizations are no longer in existence, or do not qualify as Section 501(c)(3) organizations under the Code, then to such an organization or organizations organized and operating exclusivelv for charitable, educational, religious, scientific purposes, as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code (or the corresponding provisions of any future revision of the United States Internal Revenue Law), or shall be distributed to the federal government or to a state or local government, for a public purpose, as the Board of Directors shall determine.

ARTICLE XI - DISTRIBUTIONS, TAX EXEMPT STATUS

Distributions, Assets, Tax Treatment: During such period, or periods, of time (as the Corporation is treated as a private foundation) pursuant to Section 509 of the Code, the Directors must distribute the Corporation's income at such time and in such manner so as not to subject the Corporation to tax under Section 4942 of the Code, and the Corporation is prohibited from engaging in any act of self dealing (as defined in I.R.C. § 4941(d)), which would subject the Corporation to tax under Section 4943 of the Code, from making any investments or otherwise acquiring assets in such a manner as to subject the Corporation to tax under Section 4944 of the Code, retaining any assets which would subject the Corporation to tax under Section 4944 of the Code, if the Directors have acquired such assets, and from making any taxable expenditures defined in I.R.C. § 4945(d)).

Activities: Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles of Incorporation, the Corporation shall not directly or indirectly carry on any activity which would prevent it from obtaining exemption from federal income taxation as a Corporation described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Code, or cause it to lose such exempt status, or carry on any activity not

permitted to be carried on by the Corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Code.
