The purpose for which the corporation is organized is:

This corporation is organized exclusively to provide scholarships to students entering the nursing profession or to students that have lost a parent that worked as a nurse in the nursing profession.

This Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, literary, and educational purposes, including for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or any corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Upon the dissolution of the corporation any assets remaining will be distributed to another corporation serving a similar purpose and qualifying as a tax-exempt, charitable organization under the provisions of 501 (C)(3) of the Internal Revenue code, or the corresponding section of future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.
