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### ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF TALLAHASSEE, FLORIDA ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT FOUNDATION OF SARASOTA COUNTY, INC. OF

(A Corporation Not for Profit)

In order to form a corporation under and in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, I hereby make, adopt and subscribe the following Articles of Incorporation:

## NAME OF CORPORATION

The name of this corporation shall be:

#### 11. **PURPOSES**

The purposes for which the corporation is organized are exclusively charitable, religious, scientific, literary and educational within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

The general nature, objects and purposes of the corporation shall be to operate without profit and to accept and receive property of whatever kind, and wherever situate, received by it by gift, grant, purchase, devise, bequest, or in any lawful manner and to administer and distribute such property exclusively for health, welfare, scientific, educational, environmental, cultural and other charitable purposes, including:

- To distribute property in accordance with the terms of gifts, bequests, or devises made to the corporation which are not inconsistent with its purposes;
- To modify any restriction or condition on the administration and distribution of funds for any specified purpose consistent herewith if in the sole judgment of the board of directors, such restriction or condition becomes, in effect, unnecessary, incapable of fulfillment, or inconsistent with the designated purposes of the corporation.

The specific nature, objects and purposes of the corporation shall be to lessen the burden on government by improving the welfare of the people of Sarasota County, Florida, through Job creation therefore alleviating unemployment, relieving poverty and reducing the need for public assistance. Activities of the corporation may include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Providing technical assistance to entrepreneurs through the implementation of economic gardening.
- Creating and supporting an incubator for start up businesses.
- Educating entrepreneurs about resources, programs and assistance available to them.
- Creating and supporting a micro-loan program for entrepreneurs.
- Making grants to Sarasota County to support economic development activities.
- Researching labor market, business climate, demographics and other information that supports the economic development activities of the corporation.
- Other research or educational activities consistent with the exempt purpose of the corporation.

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth herein. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provisions of these Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501(c)(3), of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

#### III. BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The affairs of the corporation shall be managed by a board of directors consisting of not less than seven (7) persons and not more than eleven (11) persons, as determined pursuant to provisions of the Bylaws. The method of election of directors shall be as stated in the Bylaws.

This corporation reserves the right to amend, alter, change or repear any provisions contained in these Articles of Incorporation, or any amendment hereto, by the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the full board of directors of the corporation.
