The undersigned incorporator hereby forms a not for profit corporation under Chapter 617 of the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of the corporation shall be DONATE TO YOUR COMMUNITY, INC.

ARTICLE VI. RESTRICTIONS

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the

publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code. It is intended that this corporation shall have the status of a corporation which is exempt from federal income taxation under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. These Articles shall be construed accordingly, and all powers and activities of the Corporation shall be limited accordingly. This corporation shall not have members.

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.
