No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of any member, trustee, officer of the Corporation, or any private individual, except that reasonable compensation for service may be paid for services rendered to or for the Corporation ffecting one or more of its purposes, and no member, trustee, officer of

the Corporation, or any private individual shall be entitled to share in the distribution of any of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting, to influence legislation and the Corporation shall not participate in or intervene in including the publication or distribution of statements, any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.
