Articles of Incorporation of the

A Florida Not For Profit Corporation, Under Florida Statutes, Chapter 617

Article I Name

The name of the corporation shall be: Believers in Christ Church, Inc.

Article II Principle Office

The principle place of business and mailing address of the corporation shall be:

1014 S.W. Sultan Drive Port St. Lucie, FL 34953

Article III Purposes

The corporation is a religious corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized under the Florida Not-For-Profit Corporation Act exclusively for religious purposes. The specific purposes of this corporation are to:

- (1) Serve and function as a Christian church;
- (2) Promote, encourage, foster and engage in, by all proper and legitimate means, the dissemination of religious, moral and spiritual Christian teaching and instruction for the support of public and worldwide worship;
- (3) Engage the services of men and women for the pastoral ministry to be ordained, commissioned and/or licensed and carry out the ministry of Jesus Christ;
- (4) Make and collect donations for the purposes of foreign and domestic missionary work;
- (5) Make and collect donations for the public welfare; and
- (6) Participate in any other related activities permitted under the Florida Not-For-Profit Corporation Act.

Article IV Board of Directors

The corporation's board of directors shall be appointed by the Ministry Council, an ecclesiastical body of the church, to serve a three (3) year term. All officers shall be appointed annually by the board of directors.

Article V Registered Agent

Article VI Incorporator

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Article VII No Members

The corporation shall have no members.

Article VIII Exempt Purposes and Distributions

The Corporation is organized and operated exclusively for religious, charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code. No substantial part of the activities of this Corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in or intervene in any political campaign (including publishing or distributing statements) on behalf of any candidate for public office.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this Corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this Corporation, and the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on: (1) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code; or (2) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

The property of this Corporation is irrevocably dedicated to religious purposes. No part of the net income or assets of this Corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, any director, officer, member, or any private person, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered, or to make payments and distributions in furtherance of its exempt purposes.

Article IX Dissolution

Upon the winding up and dissolution of this Corporation, after paying or adequately providing for the debts and obligations of the Corporation, the remaining assets of the Corporation shall be distributed to an organization that is organized and operated exclusively for religious purposes and that is tax exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
