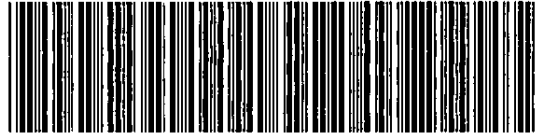

Article III Purpose: DaMauri "D-Man" Robinson Cancer Foundation is a non-profit charitable organization which financially assists families of children with cancer, which are low-income, poor or underprivileged. By providing tangible and direct financial support such as medical, prescriptions, mortgage and rental housing payments, insurance premiums, funeral expenses, utility bills, gift cards for gas, groceries, clothing, furniture, toys, etc. Families are given a greater opportunity to focus on their child's treatment and recovery.

DaMauri "D-Man" Robinson Cancer Foundation, Inc. focuses on providing support for children throughout their cancer treatment. Our goal is to allow these children to experience the amount of normality in their everyday life that they deserve. Throughout our existence we will help families and patients meet their needs.

Cancer is the leading cause of death when it comes to Children's Disease. We give from the heart, and we help provide critical funding to researchers to study children's leukemia, immune system disorders, cancerous tumors, and cells... just to name a few.

We offer a Cancer Awareness Program: this program was created to educate school

Article III:

Aged children and teens various aspects of cancer. The program runs for one month in schools in the Miami-Dade & Broward County areas.

We also offer the **"D-Man" Wish Program**: this program grants material wishes to children affected by cancer which in some circumstances are not eligible candidates to benefit from programs such as The Make a Wish Foundation, and this is why "D-Man" Wish Program was created. We interview our intake cancer patients that are underprivileged and get their history, and their wish list. Another way for us to give material wishes to critically ill patients and their families is by donating a weekend dream vacation to serve as a distraction from the child's sickness.

As an extension to the DaMauri "D-Man" Robinson Cancer Foundation Inc. we also provide outreach to homeless families, women, men and youth. Providing a Soup Kitchen and a food Bank.

Said corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501C(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III thereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income under section 501C(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170C(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Upon dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501C(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such

assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
