

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF BHAKTIVEDANTA ACADEMY OF NORTH AMERICA, INC.

(a corporation not for profit)

Article I Name

The name of the Corporation shall be: Bhaktivedanta Academy of North America, Inc.

Article II Principal Place of Business and Mailing Address

The principal place of business of this Corporation, and the Corporation's mailing address, shall be 17414 NW 112th Boulevard, Alachua, Florida 32615.

Article III Purposes

The Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational and scientific purposes under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future tax code.

The Corporation is organized especially to establish and operate one or more schools below the college level for the general academic education of children and for their education and training in the principles and practices of the Gaudiya Vaishnava religious tradition, as revealed by its acaryas in disciplic succession culminating in the teachings and personal example of His Divine Grace A.C. Bhaktivedanta Swami Prabhupada, the Founder-Acarya of The International Society for Krishna Consciousness (ISKCON), a generally recognized religious denomination.

Further, that such schools shall operate with a regular faculty, a regularly scheduled curriculum and a regularly enrolled body of students in attendance at such location as any such educational activities take place.

Further, that such schools shall admit students of any race, color, national and ethnic origin to all the rights, privileges, programs, and activities generally accorded or made available to students at the school.

Further, that this Corporation shall not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national and ethnic origin in administration of its educational policies, admissions policies, scholarship and loan programs, and athletic and other school-administered programs.

Article IV Additional Purposes

The corporation is further organized in pursuance of the following purposes of the International Society for Krishna Consciousness, a generally recognized religious denomination, as promulgated by it's Founder-Acarya, His Divine Grace A.C. Bhaktivedanta Swami Prabhupada:

- (a) To systematically propagate spiritual knowledge to society at large and to educate all people in the techniques of spiritual life in order to check the imbalance of values in life and to achieve real unity and peace in the world.
- (b) To propagate a consciousness of Krishna as He is revealed in the <u>Bhagavad-gita As It Is</u>, <u>Srimad Bhagavatam</u>, and other authorized Vedic literatures as translated and presented by His Divine Grace A.C. Bhaktivedanta Swami Prabhupada.
- (c) To bring the members of the society together with each other and nearer to Krishna, the Prime Entity, and thus to develop the idea, within the members, and humanity at large, that each soul is part and parcel of the quality of Godhead (Krishna).
- (d) To teach and encourage the Sankirtan Movement, congregational chanting of the Holy Name of God, as revealed in the teachings of Lord Sri Caitanya Mahaprabhu.
- (e) To erect for students, parents, faculty, adherents of the principles of Krishna Consciousness, and for society at large, a holy place of transcendental pastimes, dedicated to the Personality of Krishna.
- (f) To bring the members of the society closer together for the purpose of teaching a simpler and more natural way of life.
- (g) With a view towards achieving the aforementioned to publish and distribute periodicals, magazines, books and other writings.
- (h) To receive, administer and distribute funds, and to do all other necessary and proper in furtherance of the above stated purposes.

Article V Limitation of Corporate Powers

Subject to the following limitations, the Corporation may engage in any lawful act or activity for which corporations may be organized pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statutes:

(a) No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be

distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in these Articles.

- (b) No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) of any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.
- (c) Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
- (d) Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, this Corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this Corporation.

Article VI Duration

This Corporation shall exist perpetually from and after the date on which these Articles are filed with the Department of State, unless sooner dissolved voluntarily or by law.

Article VII Dedication of Assets

The property of this Corporation is irrevocably dedicated to charitable purposes as set forth above, and no part of the net income or assets of this Corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officer or member thereof, or to the benefit of any private individual.

Article VIII Distribution of Assets Upon Dissolution

Upon the dissolution of the Corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the Corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the corporation exclusively to other educational institutes or schools within the International Society for Krishna Consciousness in accord with the educational and religious purposes of the Corporation, in a manner determined by the Directors, provided, however, that the recipient organization shall be qualified for tax exempt status

under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code at the time the corporation's assets are to be distributed.

Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of, by a court of competent jurisdiction, to another charitable organization exempt from federal taxation under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code that serves similar charitable purposes to those served by this Corporation.

Article XIII Manner of Election of Directors and Corporate Governance

The number of Directors, and the method of their election, shall be as set forth in the Bylaws of the Corporation, provided, however, that at no time shall the Corporation have less than three (3) directors, or such greater or lesser number of Directors as are then required by Florida law.

Article XIV Amendment of the Articles of Incorporation

Amendments to these Articles of Incorporation may be made by a two-thirds (2/3) majority vote of the Board of Directors at any meeting called for that purpose.
