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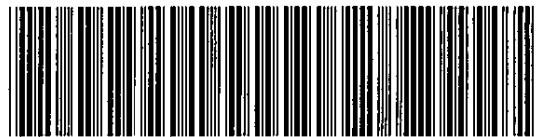

**Article # 111 : Aims and objectives**

The aims and objectives of The Caribbean–American Alliance of Florida, Inc.(CAAFL) shall be to promote and foster a spirit of understanding and co-operation among its members and all diverse people in our communities. To plan and implement scholarship programs through fund raising efforts, donations and gifts, and to assist economically disadvantaged students with tuition and encouragement toward higher education and becoming positive role models. To encourage members to take an active interest in civic and educational activities. To promote social, cultural and recreational activities and develop relationships with other local groups and organizations.

**Article # V11: Corporation organized as:**

The Caribbean-Alliance of Florida Inc. (CAAFL) is a non-profit voluntary service organization that is administered by an elected Board of nine (9) Officers and Directors and is supported by a number of standing committees. Our members at large is provided with the opportunity of serving on the educational, cultural, youth and all out-reach committees.

**Said organization is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code. Officers and Directors, and those who serve as such, shall serve without remuneration and no officer or director shall directly or indirectly receive any profit or remuneration in any capacity whatsoever for his/her position.**

**Article # V111: Dissolution**

Upon the dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

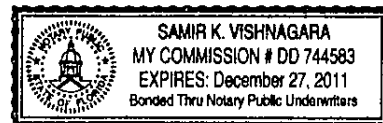

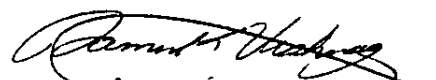

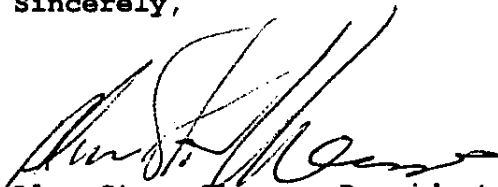
