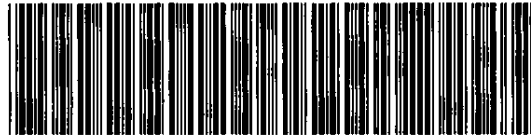

**ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT
TO
ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION**

**GODBY HIGH SCHOOL JROTC BOOSTERS, INC.
(A Florida Not for Profit Corporation)**

Pursuant to the provisions of section 617.1002 and 617.1006, Florida Statutes, the undersigned Florida nonprofit corporation adopts the following articles of amendment to its articles of incorporation.

MANNER OF ADOPTION:

The amendment(s) was (were) adopted by the members and the number of votes cast for the amendment was sufficient for approval.

THE AMENDMENTS

The Articles of Incorporation of the Godby High School JROTC Boosters, Inc. are hereby amended as follows:

- 1. Article III of the Articles of Incorporation is hereby amended to include the following. The new Article III reads as follows:**

**Article III
Corporate Purposes**

A. To promote financial support for equipment and needs not provided through the budget, sponsor fundraising projects which the membership deems beneficial and have all powers relating for all other lawful business purposes.

B. Said organization is organized exclusively for the charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

C. Upon the dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
