<u>ARTICLE OF INCORPORATION – NON- PROFIT</u> of the undersigned, a majority of whom are citizens of the United States, desiring to form a Non-Profit Corporation under the Non-Profit Corporation Law of Florida, do hereby certify:

ARTICLE ONE: The name of the Corporation shall be <u>Promiseland Christian Ministries, Non-Profit</u> Corporation.

ARTICLE TWO: Principal office of the Corporation is located at 220 North 1st. Street, Satsuma, Florida, 32189, Putnam County.
