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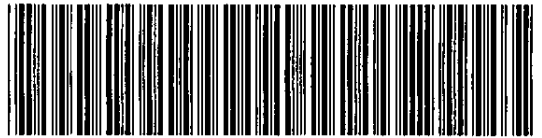

Article III. Purpose: The purpose for which this non-profit corporation is organized is:

To raise funds and distribute the funds to help pay for certain medical expenses related to
medical treatment incurred by needy individuals whose lives may be at stake as a result of
suffering from congestive heart failure, cardiomyopathy, coronary heart disease, kidney
disease, or other conditions in order to save lives.

Fast Cure Foundation, Inc. will require individuals who wish to receive help to apply in
writing for funds based upon certain criteria. These criteria include, but are not limited to,
the nature of the illness, household income level, family size, and the magnitude of
required medical treatments, etc.

Fast Cure Foundation, Inc. is organized exclusively for Charitable purposes, including the
distribution to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3)
of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code.

ARTICLE VIII: Exclusions:

No part of the net earnings of this organization shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that this organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the purposes clause hereof. No substantial part of the activities of this organization shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the organization shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of this document, the organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by an organization exempt from Federal Income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or corresponding section of any future Federal Tax Code, or (b) by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code or corresponding section of any future Federal Tax Code.

ARTICLE IX: Dissolution:

Upon the dissolution of this organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or corresponding section of any future Federal Tax Code, or shall be distributed to the Federal Government, or to a state or local government, for public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of Sumter County, Florida, exclusively for such purposes or to such organizations as said court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

ARTICLE X: Classification:

Because Fast Cure Foundation, Inc's. revenues are derived from contributions and donations of various individuals and organizations of the general public, Fast Cure Foundation is best classified as a public supported organization (public charity), described under IRC sections 509 (a)(1) and 170(b)(1)(A)(vi) as shown in box g on page 11 of the IRS Form 1023.
