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**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
OF  
FLORIDA HIGH SCHOOL FOR COLLEGE AND CAREER

The undersigned hereby forms a corporation not for profit under Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes, and, for these purposes, do hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation.

**ARTICLE I - NAME**

The name of the Corporation shall be: FLORIDA HIGH SCHOOL FOR COLLEGE AND CAREER SUCCESS - LEON COUNTY CAMPUS, INC.

**ARTICLE II - PURPOSES**

The purposes for which the Corporation is organized are:

In particular, to: establish and operate a charter school as defined in the laws of the State of Florida within the borders of Leon County, Florida. The charter school shall be organized so that it presents a system of formal instruction of its curriculum to a regularly enrolled student body through its faculty for the benefit of the general public. In particular, the Corporation will establish programs to aid and assist low-performing, over-age, grade repeating, credit deficient, 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> graders graduate from Florida public high school as well as high school students who want to improve their academic skills as they prepare for post-secondary educational options.

In general, to do any and all acts and things, and to exercise any and all powers which now or hereafter are lawful for the Corporation to do or exercise under and



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### ARTICLE III - POWERS

The Corporation shall have all the powers granted to not for profit corporations under the laws of the State of Florida which are necessary or convenient to effect any and all purposes for which the Corporation is organized. In no event, however, shall the Corporation have or exercise any power which would cause it not to qualify as a tax-exempt organization under Section 501(c)(3) or Section 170 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as hereafter amended, and the applicable rules and regulations thereunder; nor shall the Corporation engage directly or indirectly in any activity which would cause the loss of such qualification. No part of the assets or the net earnings, current or accumulated, of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of any private individual.

### ARTICLE IV - MEMBERS

This Corporation shall have no Members.

### ARTICLE V - TERM OF EXISTENCE

The Corporation shall have perpetual existence.

### ARTICLE VI - OFFICERS

The affairs of the Corporation in operating the charter school shall be managed on a day-to-day basis by the principal of the school. The Board of Directors shall set policy for the Corporation including but not limited to, the academic, financial and operation policies of the charter school, with the principal charged to implement these policies pursuant to the Bylaws. The Chairman of the Board of Directors shall serve for a term of two (2) years and the Vice Chairman and Secretary/Treasurer shall serve for a term of one (1) year, beginning the 1st day of the month immediately following his or
