ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF NELSON GULF ESTATES HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION, INCOUR JAN 20 PM 3: 11

A NON-PROFIT CORPORATION

The undersigned, acting as incorporator of a corporation pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I

Name: The name of the corporation is NELSON GULF ESTATES HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION, INC.

ARTICLE II

Principal Place of Business and Mailing Address: The principal place of business and the mailing address of this corporation shall be: 218 Route 94, Vernon, NJ 07642

ARTICLE III

Purpose: The purpose for which the corporation is organized is to administer and enforce the Declaration of Covenants and Restrictions of Nelson Gulf Estates Subdivision as an association and to engage in any lawful purpose or purposes not for pecuniary profit. In addition, the corporation shall have the following powers:

- (a) to operate and maintain the surface water management system facilities of the corporation; including all inlets, ditches, swales, culverts, water control structures, retention and detention areas, ponds, lakes, floodplain compensation areas, wetlands and any associated buffer areas, and wetland mitigation areas.
- (b) To make and collect assessments against members as Unit Owners to defray the costs, expenses and losses of operation.
- (c) To use the proceeds of assessments in the exercise of its powers and duties.
- (d) To maintain, repair, replace and operate the Association property.
- (e) To purchase insurance upon the Association property and insurance for the protection of the Association and its members as Unit Owners.
- (f) To make and amend reasonable rules and regulations respecting the use of the Association property.
- (g) To sue and be sued and to enforce by legal means, the provisions of Chapter 720, Florida Statutes, the Declaration of Restrictions, these Articles of Incorporation, Bylaws of the Association and the regulations for use of the property of the Association.
- (h) To contract for the management or operation of portions of the common areas susceptible to separate management or operation.

- (i) To employ personnel to perform the services required for proper operation and maintenance of the Association property.
- (j) To acquire or enter into agreements whereby it acquires leaseholds, memberships or other possessory or use interests in real and personal property, to declare expenses in connection therewith to be common expenses, and to adopt covenants and restrictions relating to the use thereof.

ARTICLE IV

Directors: The affairs of the corporation are to be managed by the Board of Directors. There shall be no less than three and no more than seven Directors at any given time. The method of election or appointment of Directors to the Board shall be as stated in the Bylaws. There shall be three members of the initial Board of Directors who shall continue to serve as such unless and until additional or replacement Directors are either appointed or elected to the Board as provided in the By-Laws.
