ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

<u>OF</u>

OAKMONT PARK ASSOCIATION, INC.

We, the undersigned, for the purpose of forming a Corporation, not for profit, under and pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statutes of 1971, do herewith and hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation, to-wit:

1

The name of the corporation shall be OAKMONT PARK ASSOCIATION, INC., and it shall be located in Indian River County, Florida, and its headquarters shall be located in Vero Beach, Indian River County, Florida.

The purposes for which the Corporation is organized shall be to preserve, protect, and promote the interest of the property owners of Oakmont Park Estates, Units 1, 2, 3 and 4, as per plats filed in Plat Book 7, page 38, Plat Book 7 page 75, Plat Book 7 page 81 and Plat Book 8 page 2, respectively.

The membership of the Corporation shall be governed by its Board of Directors, consisting of 7 Directors elected by the membership. Each Director shall serve for two years. On alternate years, the membership shall elect 3 Directors, and then 4 Directors. Directors shall be eligible for re-election. The officers of the Association shall consist of: President, Vice President, and Secretary-Treasurer. These shall be elected from the Board of Directors, by The Board of Directors. Any member shall be eligible to be a director.

IV

Annual Election: (a) The election of Directors shall take place in the month of March each year. Members shall be notified in writing at least two weeks prior to said elections, and the notification shall be accompanied by a ballot and a return-addressed envelope.

Votes shall be counted within one week following the deadline for return of ballots, and the new Board of Directors shall meet during the month of March to elect the officers for the coming corporation year.

- (b) The newly elected officers shall take office immediately upon their election.
- (c) Notice of the new slate of officers and directors shall be sent to the press and the membership immediately following the annual meeting.
- (d) A nominating committee composed of three members, at least one of whom shall be a director, shall be named each year by the President. It shall submit a slate of nominees for the openings on the Board of Directors, and it shall be responsible for the mailing out of the ballots to members by March 1, of each year. Return of ballots by March 10 shall be stipulated in the ballot instructions.
- (e) The term of office for the Officers of the Corporation shall be one year, subject to re-election by an incoming Board of Directors.
- (f) Interim appointments to the Board, or to a position as an officer, shall be made by the Directors to fill any vacancy created and such substitution shall be held until the expiration of the term held by the vacating member.

Meetings: (a) The Board of Directors will meet monthly. A statement of the business transacted will be sent to the members. A majority of its members shall constitute a quorum, and a majority of those present shall govern.

(b) The Directors may call a meeting of the membership as a whole, with members being given proper notice in writing of the time and place at least one week in advance of such meeting.

VI

Membership: Ownership of property in one of the fout Units of Oakmont Park Estates is

a condition precident to membership of the Corporation, and upon disposition of such ownership by any member, the membership in the Corporation is terminated thereby.

VII

Dues shall be Ten Dollars per House per year. The Board of Directors shall have the right to suggest a change in yearly dues, subject to the approval of the members at the annual meeting. Failure to make payment of yearly dues as herein provides is just cause for expulsion of the member, at the option of the Board of Directors at a meeting called therefor.
