ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

CHRIST FELLOWSHIP HEALING TEMPLE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT
CORPORATION

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ARTICLE I

The name and address of this principal corporation is Christ Fellowship Healing Temple Community Development Corporation, 11478 Silk Carnation Way, Royal Palm Beach, Florida, 33411, located in Palm Beach County, Florida. The Corporation is organized pursuant to the Florida Non-profit Corporation Code.

ARTICLE 2

This Corporation is a non-profit public benefit corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. The corporation is organized under the Non-profit Public Benefit Corporation Law for charitable and educational purposes to aid the poor and disadvantaged individuals and families toward a life of self-sufficiency. The programs will consist of but shall not be limited to: Teenage Pregnancy, Aids, Elderly Care, Substance Abuse and Prevention, Job Training, and Acquisition, Employment, Tutoring, Literacy, Teenage Empowerment Offender Rehabilitation, Temporary Shelter, and other programs to aid those in need.

ARTICLE 3

The purposes for which this Corporation is formed and the business and objects to be carried on and promoted by it are as follows:

The purpose for which the corporation is organized are to receive and maintain real, or personal property, or both, and subject to the restrictions and limitations hereinafter set forth to use and apply the whole or any part of the income there from and the principal thereof exclusively for charitable, religious, scientific, literary or educational purposes either directly or by

contributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501 C (3) of the Internal Revenue Code and regulations issued pursuant thereto as they now exist or as they may hereafter be amended.

The specific purpose for which the corporation is organized shall be to do all things in which a Not For Profit Corporation can do within and without the U.S..

To erect and maintain a building or buildings for the above purpose and to engage in any operations incidental to and essential to carry out the purposes above mentioned

To solicit funds and donations in kind and from time to time to further the purposes of this corporation.

To acquire and receive by purchase, donation or other wise any property, real personal or mixed and to hold use and dispose of the same.

To borrow money and to issue evidence of indebtedness in furtherance of any of the objects of its business; and to secure loans by mortgage, pledge, deed of trust or other liens.

To apply for obtain and contract with an federal state or local government or agency for a direct loan or other financial aid in the form of grants or otherwise relating to the purposes of this corporation.

To engage in any kind of activity and to enter into perform and carry out contracts of any kind, necessary or in connection with or incidental to the accomplishment of any one or more of the non-profit programs or purposes of the Corporation.

No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to any directors or officer of the Corporation or any member of the Corporation or any other private individual except that reasonable compensation may be paid for services rendered to or for the Corporation affecting one or more of its purposes. And no director or officer of the Corporation or any private individual shall be entitled to share in the distribution of any of the corporate assets on dissolution of the Corporation.

Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles the Corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be conducted or carried on by an organization except from taxation under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code or (2) by a corporation contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (C) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code.

ARTICLE 4

The duration of this Corporation shall be perpetual. There shall be no stock and there shall not be members.

ARTICLE 5

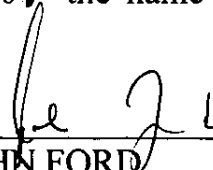
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ARTICLE 7
