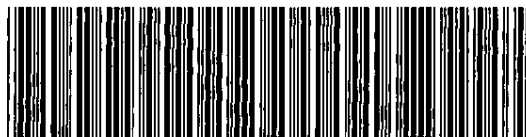

ARTICLE I NAME

ARTICLE III PURPOSE

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is:

The Insurance Appraisal and Umpire Association, a Florida not-for-profit Corporation has been formed to establish and maintain the highest level of professional standards and services.

Officers shall be elected by those members belonging to the "general membership" group at each Annual Meeting of the Association for a term of one (1) year beginning immediately following each Annual Convention

With the inception of the Ladder at the initial election, each Officer will be elected individually for that office which he or she is nominated. Subsequent to this election and after performing satisfactory service in that office for the term of one year, each Officer shall ascend to the next office in the following year. The President shall leave office after his term of one year. With the ascension of all other Officers, the Office of Secretary will be left open. New general members will then be nominated for the Office of Secretary for the upcoming year. A slate of Officers will be presented at the Annual Convention and shall include the newly ascended Officers into their respective positions with the nominee for Secretary. At that time, competing nominees for Secretary and the five (5) non-officer Board Members can be submitted by the general membership and voted on accordingly. A majority vote by the membership present at the meeting will induct the new slate of Officers into office.

Officers shall serve without compensation. All Officers shall be members of the Board of Directors.
