ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

Win Our Nations, Inc.

A Non Profit Corporation

The undersigned, being over the age of eighteen (18) years and competent to contract, for the purpose of organizing a Corporation not-for-profit purpose. does hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation, and does hereby agree and certify as follows:

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of this Corporation shall be Win Our Nations, Inc.

ARTICLE II PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The physical and mailing address of the principal office of Win Our Nations, Inc. 1001 Greenwood Way Cocoa, FL 32922

ARTICLE III PURPOSE AND POWERS

(1) The purpose for which the Corporation is organized and operated is exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code. Such purposes shall include the following:

Assisting orphanages, develop water projects in rural areas, and spreading the Good News of Jesus Christ.

- (2) As a means of accomplishing the above purposes and methods, the Corporation shall have the following powers:
 - (a) To receive and accept gifts of money and property and to hold the same for any of the purposes of the Corporation and its work.
 - (b) To raise and assist in raising funds for the purposes herein set forth, including the issuance of bonds or other instruments of credits.
 - (c) To acquire, own, lease, mortgage and dispose of property both real and personal.
 - (d) To accept property and donations in trust for religious or charitable purposes.

- (3) The property of the Corporation is irrevocable dedicated to religious, educational and charitable purposes, and no part of the net earnings of the corporation/organization shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, directors, officers or other private persons, except that the corporation/organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of Section 501 (c)(3) purposes.
- (4) No substantial part of the activities of the corporation/organization shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation/organization shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office.
- (5) The Corporation shall not:
 - (a) operate for the purpose of carrying on a trade or business for profit;
 - (b) accumulate income, invest income, or divert income, in a manner endangering its exempt status; or(c) except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activity or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of the Corporation.

ARTICLE IV MANNER OF ELECTION

Directors shall be elected as set forth in the Corporation's Bylaws.

ARTICLE V INITIAL BOARD OF DIRECTORS

This Corporation shall have five (5) directors initially. The number of directors may be either increased or diminished from time to time in accordance with the Bylaws, but shall never be less than three (3). The name and street addresses of the initial directors of this Corporation are:



- (2) by a corporation/organization, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the I.R.S. Code (or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code.)
 - (a) Upon dissolution of this corporation/organization assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the Federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.

ARTICLE X AMENDMENT

This Corporation reserves the right to amend or repeal any provisions contained in these articles of incorporation, or any amendment hereto.
