ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

In Compliance with Chapter 617, F.S., (Not for Profit)

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the corporation shall be:

Little Links Enrichment Center, Inc.



ARTICLE III **PURPOSE**

The purpose for which the corporation is organized and the business and the objects to be carried on and promoted by it are as follows:

- 1. To receive and maintain real or personal property, or both, and subject to restrictions and limitations hereinafter set forth, to use and apply the whole and any part of the income therefrom and the principal thereof exclusively for charitable, religious, scientific, literary, or educational purposes either directly or by contributing to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and regulations issued pursuant thereto as they now exist or as they may hereafter be amended.
- 2. The specific purpose for which the organization is organized is: Pre K 12 private school, providing educational and therapeutic services to students with exceptional educational needs.
- 3. To erect and maintain a building or buildings for the above purpose and to engage in any operation incidental to and essential to carry out the purposes above mentioned.
- 4. To solicit funds and donations in kind to further the purposes of this corporation.
- 5. To acquire and receive by purchase, donation, or otherwise, any property, real, personal or mixed, and to hold, use and dispose of same.





- 6. To borrow money and issue evidence of indebtedness in furtherance of any or all of the objects of its business; and to secure loans by mortgage, pledge, deed of trust, or other lien.
- 7. To apply for, obtain and contract with any federal, state or local government or agency for a direct loan or loans or other financial aid in the form of grants or otherwise relating to the purposes of this corporation.
- 8. To engage in any kind of activity, and to enter into, perform and carry out contracts of any kind, necessary or in connection with, or incidental to the accomplishment of any one or more of the non-profit purposes of this corporation.
- 9. No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to any Director or Officer of the Corporation or any member of the corporation or any other private individual (except that reasonable compensation may be paid for services rendered to or for the corporation affecting one or more of its purposes).
- 10. Notwithstanding any other provisions of these Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be conducted or carried on by an organization exempt from taxation under Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and Regulations issued pursuant thereto as they now exist or as they may hereafter be amended, or by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170 (c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code and said Regulations as they now exist or may hereafter be amended.
- 11. Upon dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors shall, disposes of all of the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or any corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), as the board of directors shall determine. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Circuit Court of Miami-Dade County, Florida in which the principal office is located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said script shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
- 12. The corporation shall have such powers as are inferred upon it by Chapter 617 of the Laws of the State of Florida, and to exercise those powers in the accomplishment of its objectives and purposes.
- 13. The Bylaws may impose other conditions of membership from time to time.
