ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION Sustainable Green America Inc.

ARTICLE I NAME/REGISTERED OFFICE

The name of this corporation shall is:

Sustainable Green America, Inc.

ARTICLE II BUSINESS ADDRESS

The principal place of business is:

1742 Madison Ivy Circle, Apopka, Florida 32712

ARTICLE III PURPOSE

Sustainable Green America Inc. is a non-profit organization whose purpose is to:

- 1. Provide formal training in "Green Initiatives" for underprivileged individuals to enable them to become self-sufficient through gainful employment in "Green Jobs".
- 2. Provide businesses with trained workers in the emerging and growing "Green Industry".
- 3. To promote environmental responsibility to the public through education.

This corporation is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as now enacted or hereafter amended, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that also qualify as Section 501(c)(3) exempt organizations. All funds, whether income or principal, and whether acquired by gift or contribution or otherwise, shall be devoted to said purposes.

ARTICLE IV LIMITATIONS

At all times the following shall operate as conditions restricting the operations and activities of the corporation:

1. No part of the net earnings of Sustainable Green America Inc. shall inure to any member of the corporation not qualifying as exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as now enacted or hereafter amended, any officer of the corporation, nor to any other private persons, excepting solely such reasonable compensation that the corporation shall pay for services actually rendered to the corporation, or allowed by the corporation as a reasonable allowance for authorized expenditures incurred on behalf of the corporation;



- 2. No substantial part of the activities of Sustainable Green America Inc. shall constitute the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, or any initiative or referendum before the public, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including by publication or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office; and
- 3. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, Sustainable Green America Inc., shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as now enacted or hereafter amended.

ARTICLE V ELECTION/APPOINTMENT OF DIRECTORS

Directors shall be elected by the members at the annual meeting of the membership. Directors of the initial board shall serve until the first annual meeting, at which their successors will be duly elected and qualified, or removed as provided in the bylaws.

The eligibility, rights and obligations of the Directors will be determined by the organization's bylaws. The management of the affairs of the corporation shall be vested in a board of directors, as defined by the corporation's bylaws. No director shall have any right, title, or interest in or to any property of the corporation.
