ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

In Compliance with Chapter 617, F.S., (Not for Profit)

SECRETARY OF STATE DIVISION OF CORPORATIONS

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the corporation shall be:

Gramercy Park Neighborhood Corporation, Inc.

ARTICLE II PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation shall be:

5941 Bahama Court West Palm Beach, FL 33407

ARTICLE III PURPOSE

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is:

- A. This corporation is a not for profit corporation organized under Chapter 617, Florida Statutes. It is not organized for the private gain of any person. The specific purposes of this corporation are for the improvement and promotion of the neighborhood known as Gramercy Park Neighborhood Corporation, Inc. for the benefit of the residents.
- B. To exercise all rights and powers conferred by the laws of the State of Florida upon nonprofit corporations.
- C. Provided, however, that the corporation shall not engage in any action which is not permitted to be carried on by nonprofit corporations under the Internal Revenue Code and no part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its members, directors, or officers, but the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation to these people for services rendered, and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of its stated purposes.
- D. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.
- E. Upon dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes with the meaning of Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state of local government for a public purpose. As such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court in the County in which the principal office of the Corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

ARTICLE IV · MANNER OF ELECTION

The manner in which the directors are elected or appointed:

The Corporation shall have Voting Members, who shall be elected (and may be removed) by the Voting Members, and who shall have all the rights and privileges of members of the Corporation.
