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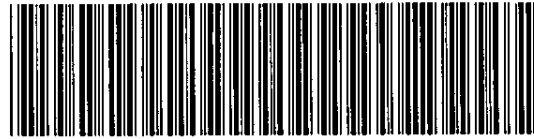

## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned, acting as the incorporator of the corporation, pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, files the following Articles of Incorporation:

### ARTICLE 1

The name of the corporation shall be Leon High School Lacrosse Boosters, Inc.

### ARTICLE 2

The principal place of business and mailing address of the corporation is Leon High School, 550 East Tennessee Street, Tallahassee, Florida 32308.

### ARTICLE 3

The purposes for which the corporation is organized are exclusively charitable and educational within the meaning of Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or the corresponding provision of any future federal tax code. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from federal income tax under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or the corresponding provision of any future federal tax code, and the assets of the corporation are permanently dedicated to one or more of the exempt purposes recognized by Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or the corresponding provision of any future federal tax code, or to the federal, state, or local government for a public purpose. The period of the duration of the corporation is perpetual, unless dissolved according to law. Subject to the limitations applicable to Section 501(c) (3) organizations, the corporation shall have the general powers set forth in Section 617.0302, Florida Statutes. However, no part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in these articles, and the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or the corresponding provision of any future federal tax code.

### ARTICLE 4

The directors of the corporation shall be elected as stated in the bylaws. The members shall have the exclusive right to amend the bylaws.

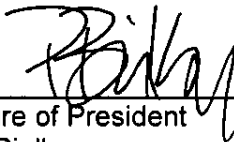
