The undersigned, acting as incorporators of this Corporation pursuant to Chapter 617 of the Florida Statues, hereby forms a corporation not for profit under the laws of the State of Florida and adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation.

Article I.

NAME OF CORPORATION

The name of this Corporation shall be LIGHT OF HOPE OUT REACH, INC.

Article II

ADDRESS OF PRINCIPAL OFFICE AND MAILING ADDRESS OF CORPORATION

The address of the principal office of the Corporation is 209 E Pearl Street Minneola Fl 34715 and the mailing address of the Corporation is 209 E Pearl Street Minneola Fl 34715

Article III.

PURPOSES AND POWERS OF THE CORPORATION

A. The Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, educational, scientific and literary, community outreach, homeless outreach, youth outreach, drug intervention outreach, transitional home outreach services, opportunities and purposes, including for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code. The Corporation may receive and administer funds for scientific, educational, and charitable purposes, within the meaning of Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended or such corresponding section of any future federal tax code (hereinafter referred to as the "Code"). To the extent consistent with the preceding sentence and permissible under Florida law, the purposes of this

Corporation shall include, but shall not be limited to: provide charitable, education, scientific and/or literary opportunities to all of Central Florida, and the surrounding communities; and to provide education in a private school setting.

- B. This Corporation shall be authorized to carry out any and all acts and to exercise any and all corporate powers which may now or hereafter be lawful under the laws of the State of Florida to the extent applicable to corporations not for profit and that are not inconsistent with these Articles of Incorporation.
- C. Notwithstanding anything contained in these articles of Incorporation to the contrary, the following provisions shall apply:
 - 1. No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall insure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, directors, trustees, officers, or private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered to the corporation and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in this Article III.
 - 2. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in or intervene in any political campaign (including publishing or distributing statements) on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.
 - 3. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles of Incorporation, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section (c)(3) of the code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Code.
 - 4. If the Corporation is, or shall ever be, classified as a "private foundation", as defined in Section 509(a) of the Code, the following provisions shall apply for so long as it remains a private foundation:
 - (i) The Corporation will not engage in any act of self-dealing as defined in section 4941(d) of the Code.
 - (ii) The Corporation will distribute its income for each tax year at such time an in such manner as not to become

- subject to the tax on undistributed income imposed by Section 4942 of the Code.
- (iii) The Corporation will not retain any excess business holdings as defined in Section 4943(c) of the Code.
- The Corporation will not make any investments in such (iv) manner as to subject it to tax under Section 4944 of the Code.
- The Corporation will not make any taxable (v) expenditures as defined in Section 4945(d) of the Code.

Article IV

ELECTION OF DIRECTORS

- A. The Board of Directors of the Corporation shall be elected as provided in the Bylaws. The number of directors may be increased or decreased from time to time in accordance with the Bylaws of this Corporation, but shall never be less than four(4).
 - B. The initial number of directors of this Corporation shall be seven (7). The names and addresses of the initial members of the Board of Directors, who shall hold office for the first year of existence of this Corporation or until their successors are elected or appointed and have qualified, are:
