ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

(A Florida Not-For Profit Corporation)

Article I NAME

The name of this corporation shall be Families And Children In Transition, Inc., (hereinafter called the "Corporation").

Article II PRINCIPAL OFFICE AND/OR MAILING ADDRESS

ARTICLE III PURPOSE

This Corporation is a not-for-profit corporation, organized for the purpose of assisting families and children, one at a time, during a dramatic change in their lives, while in transition from point A to point B by assisting them with sponsorships, resources, shelter, clothing, food, transportation, funds for medical treatment, and in the process ministering to them and coaching them on life's lesson's by delivering scripture verses and teachings while the blessings are on route. No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its directors, officers, members or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of any of its purposes. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting, to influence legislation (except as otherwise provided in subsection (h) of Section 501 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986), and the Corporation shall not participate or intervene in (including the publishing or distributing of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).
