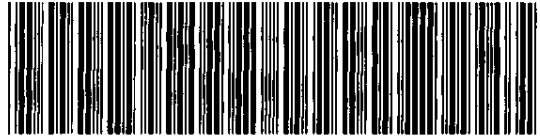

**ARTICLE III PURPOSE**

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is:

Non-Profit Purpose

This corporation is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501 (c) 3 of IRS Code 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future US Internal Revenue Law.

Specific Purpose

To provide job training to the underserved and/or low income families including literacy, after-school tutoring, and other skill enhancement programs including referral services and community networking.

Limitation of Powers

Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles of Incorporation, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501© 3 and 170 © 2 of the IRS Code of 1986 or corresponding provision of any future US Internal Revenue Law.

Dissolution

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
