ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OS MAR 20 PM 1: 04
TALLAHASSEE FLORIDA

(A Florida Corporation Not for profit)

We, the undersigned Subscribers to, these Articles of Incorporation, each a natural person competent to contract, hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose of constituting a charitable organization for faith networking, to, operate in accordance with the Laws of God and in a non-profit corporate form, pursuant to the applicable provisions of the Statutes of the State of Florida relative non-to corporations and in a not for profit; and we hereby covenant and agree a follows,.

Not withstanding any other provisions of these articles, the purposes for which the corporation is organized are exclusively religious, charitable, scientific, literary, and educational within the meaning of 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

Not withstanding any other provisions of these articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

Upon dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said court shall determine, which are organized and operated for such purposes.

This corporation is a nonprofit religious benefit corporation and is organized to spread the gospel of Jesus Christ The corporation is organized under the Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law for Religious purposes. To establish God's Holiness and present and the ark of His covenant through miracle crusades, youth crusades, daily broadcasting. Mission out reaches and global Evangelism declaring that Jesus Christ still saves and heads.

To establish structured support services Evangelistic, Economic Development and Other Ministries to support the outreach ministries for the body of Jesus Christ the Church). In

accordance with the Doctrine of the Corporation creed / by-laws as a pastor to spread the gospel of Jesus Christ The religious program will consist of, but shall not be limited to Homelessness Health Care, Child Care, Youth At High Risk, Tutorial. Land Acquisition Counseling Employment, Christian Education and other programs to aid those in need.

The purpose of the corporation shall be: to cultivate, promote, promulgate and extend, educational and charitable works, such as drug rehabilitation counseling and facilities, feeding program for the elderly, growth and development of young men through mentoring, to provide the spiritual education, training, experience, support and evaluation needed to guide and prepare our young male for their roles as men, adults and leaders in their homes, schools, churches and communities and women in distress counseling; to teach and help people of all race, creed and color by ways of media; to adopt, and establish By-laws, and management of its affairs, in accordance with the law and not inconsistent with these Articles of incorporation; take, manage and, dispose of property, real and personal, buy and sell of the Corporation. To borrow money contract debt, and lease bonds notes and debentures, and secure payments or performance of its obligations. To do all acts necessary or expedient for the administration of the affairs and attainment of the purpose of the corporation, including e.g., the establishment of schools, seminars, youth center, etc. oriented to organizational principles. Being able to service, setup, operate in foreign and domestic, national and international, {global} boundaries.

To raise the economic, educational and social levels of the underprivileged residents of Broward and Dade County, and other surrounding counties in Florida, and other similar communities, who are substantially underemployed and have income, who are proportionately more after victims of crime, by fostering and promoting community wide interest and concern for problems of such residents, and to that end; (a) Racial tension, prejudice, discrimination, economic and otherwise, be eliminated; (b) Sickness, poverty and crime may be lessened; and (c) Educational and economic opportunities may be expanded among the residents of Broward and Dade County, Florida and other surrounding areas. Section 10.1 Conflict Of Interest Any director, officer, or key employee who has an interest in a contract, salary negotiation, or other transaction presented to the Board or a committee there of for authorization, approval, or ratification shall make a prompt and full disclosure of his interest to the Board or committee prior to its acting on such contract or transaction. Such disclosure shall include any relevant and material facts known to such person about the contract or transaction which might reasonably be construed to be adverse to the corporation's interest.

The body to which such disclosure is made shall thereupon determine, by a vote of seventy-five (75%) of the votes entitled to vote, whether the disclosure shows that a conflict of interest exists or can reasonably be construed to exist. If a conflict is deemed to exist, such person shall not vote on, nor use his personal influence on, nor participate (other than to present factual information or to respond to questions) in, the discussions or deliberations with respect to such contract or transaction. Such person may be counted in determining whether a quorum is present but may not be counted when the Board of Directors or a committee of the Board takes action on the transaction. The minutes of the meeting shall reflect the disclosure made, the vote thereon and, where applicable, the abstention from voting and participation, and whether a quorum was present.
