Articles of Incorporation of Courts of Praise Deliverance Ministries, Inc

This corporation is organized exclusively for one or more of the purposes as specified in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. This Corporation shall be a nonprofit corporation. The specific purpose for which this corporation is organized is to grow towards maturity in faith and gathering for worship, for study of God's Word and for the nurture and care of all ages, to also operate and maintain a House of Worship in accordance to the Christian Faith. Our purpose is to teach the gospel of Jesus Christ. To worship God according to the faith, ritual and discipline of the Bible, to promote religious education and to perform such activities as are incident, pertinent, and related thereto. The congregation or corporation acknowledges itself to be a member of, and belongs to, the Courts of Praise Deliverance Ministries, Inc. and that as such it accedes to, recognizes and adopts the constitution, canons or ecclesiastical laws, doctrines, discipline and worship of the Courts of Praise Deliverance Center, Inc.
