ARTICLE OF INCORPORATION

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FIRST CHURCH OF GOD OF THE CHOSEN-ONE, BECRETARY OF STATE SALLAHASSEE, FLORIDA

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of this corporation shall be: First Church of God of the Chosen-one, Inc

ARTICLE II - DURATION

This corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE III - PURPOSE
