ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

The undersigned do hereby associate for the purpose of becoming a not for profit corporation under the laws of the State of Florida, and do hereby certify that the following Articles of Incorporation have been adopted:

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation is Victory Scholarship Foundation, Inc.

ARTICLE II

The street address of the initial registered office of this corporation is 3890 Dunn Avenue Suite 804, Jacksonville, FL 32218 and the name of the initial registered agent at that address is Deborah Maiden. The principal office address and mailing address of this corporation is 3890 Dunn Avenue Suite 804, Jacksonville, FL 32218.

ARTICLE III

This corporation has the purpose or powers as may be stated in these articles of incorporation, and such additional purposes or powers as may be granted hereafter. The primary purpose of this corporation is:


