

Articles of Incorporation of

United Against Mental Illness Foundation, Inc.

This corporation is organized exclusively for one or more of the purposes as specified in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. This Corporation shall be a nonprofit corporation. The specific purpose for which this corporation is organized is to create innovative approaches towards psychiatric research using the internet as a medium for the collaboration of research and ideas with other medical and free-lance researchers. Providing families affected by mental illnesses with a source of information that can offer hope for the future cures of even the worst types of mental illnesses and educating the general public about mental illnesses and its affect. We do this through community advocacy events, charity music festivals, and campaigns.

Upon the dissolution of this corporation, its assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of this corporation shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.
