ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

STEADFAST AND UNMOVABLE MINISTRIES, INC

ARTICLE ONE

NAME

The name of this corporation is **STEADFAST AND UNMOVABLE MINISTRIES, INC.**

ARTICLE TWO

DURATION

This corporation shall exist in perpetuity.

ARTICLE THREE

PURPOSE

- (A) This corporation shall be a non-profit organization formed for general corporate purposes; for the purpose of facilitating and executing the business and activities of the **STEADFAST AND UNMOVABLE MINISTRIES, INC.**, within or without the State of Florida; to meet the requirements of the laws of the State of Florida in regard to the acquiring, mortgaging and disposition of real estate within the State of Florida; and to conduct any and all business of the corporation.
- (B) The corporation is organized exclusively for religious purposes, including for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt under Section 501(C)(3) within the meaning of any current Internal Revenue Service law or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue law. Its further purpose is to operate a church institution under all of the **STEADFAST AND UNMOVABLE MINISTRIES, INC.**, policies, by-laws for this corporation as completed, and to propagate the gospel of Jesus Christ on this earth under the name and style of

the **STEADFAST AND UNMOVABLE MINISTRIES, INC**. The church shall be controlled and administered in accordance with the doctrine of the Holy Bible and shall accept the New Testament of the Bible as the rule of faith, practice and teaching.

ARTICLE FOUR

POWERS

- (A) Notwithstanding any other provisions of these Articles, the purposes for which the corporation is organized are exclusively charitable, literary, and educational within the meaning of Section 501(C)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 2009 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.
- (B) No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Three hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(C)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(C)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

(C) Ownership of all church property, real and personal, is vested in the congregation. In the event of the dissolution of this corporation, to the extent allowed

under applicable law, all of the assets of the corporation remaining after payment of all debts and liabilities of the corporation shall be distributed to, or its assets sold and the proceeds distributed to, another organization organized and operating, or to one or more corporations, funds or foundations organized and operating exclusively for religious, charitable, literary or educational purposes, which shall be selected by the Board of Trustees of the corporation, provided, however, that any such recipient organization or organizations shall at that time qualify as exempt from taxation under the provisions of the current Internal Revenue Service Code or the corresponding provisions of any subsequent law.

(D) This corporation shall issue no stock, and no part of the net earnings shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributed to, its members, trustees, directors, officers or others.

ARTICLE FIVE

TRUSTEES/DIRECTORS

The affairs of the corporation shall be managed by at least three (3) voting trustees/directors. The number of trustees/directors may be increased or diminished from time to time but shall never be less than three. The method of election of the trustees/directors is as stated in the by-laws.
