

Articles of Incorporation of Legacy105, Inc.

(Not for Profit)

We, the undersigned have this 17th day of April, 2009, voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a non-profit corporation under the laws of the State of Florida, and hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

Article 1. Name

The name of this corporation is Legacy105, Incorporated, referred to hereafter as the "Corporation."

Article 2. The Principal Place of Business and Mailing Address

The initial street address of the principal office of this corporation is 416 tarpon Street, Kissimmee, Florida 34744. The Board of Directors may from time to time move the principal office to any other address in Florida.

Article 3. Purpose

The purposes for which this Corporation is organized are to establish a college access program dedicated to providing comprehensive college preparation assistance to low-income and underrepresented students and those who are the first generation in their family to attend college.

No part of the net earnings of this corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that this corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in these articles.
