ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

FIRST COAST TEA PARTY, INC.

The undersigned natural person, for the purpose of organizing and incorporating a Florida not for profit corporation adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation.

ARTICLE I

The name of this Corporation is:

FIRST COAST TEA PARTY, INC.

ARTICLE II

This is a non-profit corporation organized solely for general educational purposes pursuant to Florida Not for Profit Corporation Act.

ARTICLE III

The specific purpose for which this Corporation is formed is to educate the public on political and governmental issues.

The general purposes for which this Corporation is formed are to conduct any and all lawful activities which a not-for-profit corporation may by law conduct.

ARTICLE IV

The property of this Corporation is irrevocably dedicated to the charitable and educational purposes set forth herein and no part of the net income or assets of this Corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of any Director, Officer, or Member thereof, or to the benefit of any private individual.

ARTICLE V

The street address of the principal office of the Corporation is 1513 Orlando Circle South, Jacksonville, FL 32207.

The mailing address of the principal office of the Corporation is Post Office Box 1302, Ponte Vedra Beach, FL 32004-1302.

The name of the Registered Agent for service of process of that office shall be BILLIE J. TUCKER, whose address is 1513 Orlando Circle South, Jacksonville, FL 32207.

ARTICLE VI

The powers of this Corporation shall be exercised, its property controlled, and its affairs conducted by a Board of Directors. There shall be at least (3) Directors constituting the Board of Directors. In addition, the Board of Directors may grant such further powers to the Corporation as it may deem appropriate in the Corporation's Bylaws or otherwise as long as such powers are not in conflict with any applicable law.

ARTICLE XI

The Board of Directors may from time to time establish provisions for memberships in the Corporation separate from the Board of Directors.
