ARTICLE III- PURPOSE

- 1. The specific purpose of Groves Equine Enthusiasts, Inc. is to protect and preserve the interest of horse owners and equine enthusiasts, to encourage and sustain a variety of equine activities, and to promote and foster future growth of the equestrian community within the boundaries of Loxahatchee and surrounding areas.
- 2. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall consist of the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in, any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.
- 3. The Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational and scientific purposes, including for such purposes, the making of distributions to the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal ax code.

- 1. The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to charitable purposes and no part of the net income or assets of this corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officer, or member thereof or to the benefit of any private person.
