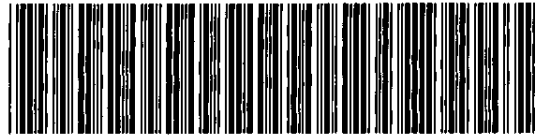

To Whom It May Concern,

My name is Lisa Waite, and I am owner and Executive Director of Arts for Humanity, a Florida non-profit corporation with document # N09000005032. When our company originally filed as a business with the IRS we were concerned that we were erroneously assigned two EIN numbers: EIN 27-0157240 and EIN 26-0157240, as while most of our paperwork received had the 27- prefix, every now and then documents would arrive with the 26- prefix.

During our recently filing of our federal form 990N, we discovered that this thought was a reality. No actual activity has been performed under the number that was originally assigned to us (and the one we gave to you), 27-0157240. All tax and activity has been performed on the number 26-0157240. We would be so appreciative if you could change our EIN to the correct number, 26-0157240. I've included a screen shot of my accepted 990N postcard so you can see the IRS has accepted this number as our actual tax document number.
