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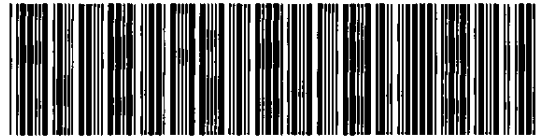

**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION**  
In Compliance with Chapter 617, F.S., (Not for Profit)

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF  
**Nickeldo.org Incorporated**  
A Florida "Not for Profit" Corporation

The undersigned, acting as incorporator of a corporation under Chapter 617 of Florida Statutes, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

**Article I.**  
**NAME OF CORPORATION**

The name of the corporation shall be Nickeldo.org Incorporated.

**Article II.**  
**INITIAL ADDRESSES OF THE CORPORATION**

**Article III.**  
**CORPORATE PURPOSES**

The purposes for which this corporation is formed are exclusively charitable, educational and scientific and consist of the following:

- a) To encourage, inspire, educate, promote, and celebrate the virtues, merits, and benefits of charity, generosity, and altruistic giving of one's wealth, goods, services and time to our local and worldwide communities, by means of proselytizing, ministering, campaigning, promoting, lecturing, praising, and setting an example of charitable giving.
- b) At no time will the corporation, in any substantive way, deviate from or alter the foregoing purposes.
- c) To do any and all lawful activities which may be necessary, useful, or desirable for the furtherance, accomplishment, fostering, or attaining of the foregoing purposes, either directly or indirectly, and either alone or in conjunction or cooperation with others, whether such others be persons or organizations of any kind or nature, such as corporations, firms, association, trusts, institution, foundations, or governmental bureaus, departments or agencies.
- d) Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

e) No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth.

f) No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

g) In the event of dissolution, all of the remaining assets and property of the Corporation shall after necessary expenses thereof be distributed to such organizations as shall qualify under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended, or to another organization to be used in such manner as in the judgment of a Judge of the Circuit Court of the County in which the principal office of the Corporation is located or pursuant to any other method authorized by Statute or substitutive law of the State of Florida which will best accomplish the general purposes for which this Corporation was formed.

#### **Article IV.** **CORPORATE DURATION**

So long that there not be, in any substantive way, deviation from or alteration to the original purpose (Article III, a), the term of existence of this corporation shall be perpetual.

#### **Article V.** **MEMBERSHIP**

Membership, within the qualifications set forth by the bylaws of the corporation, shall be open to persons, corporations, organizations that have a sincere interest in the furtherance of the corporate purpose. Qualification, voting rights and privileges of members shall be set forth in the bylaws.

#### **Article VI.** **MANNER OF ELECTION**

The directors of the corporation shall be elected by majority vote in accordance with methods and qualifications specified in the bylaws of the corporation, from individuals who are qualified for membership as set forth in these articles and by the bylaws.
