#### ARTICLE I Organizational Structure

The name of this corporation is **West Volusia Friends of Felines**, Inc. The coalition of volunteers was registered with the State of Florida on May 27, 2009 N09000005185 and with the Department of Treasury 30-0567385 on July 02, 2009. The mailing address for West Volusia Friends of Felines, Inc. is **Post Office Box1508**, **DeLand**, **Florida 32721-1508**. Website: **www.**wvfriendsoffelines.org.

### ARTICLE II Organizing Document Mission Statement

Said organization is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

This corporation is organized exclusively for charitable purposes for sterilization of feral cats within the non-profit meaning of Section 501 I (3) of the Internal Revenue Code for making this an exempt organization. All funds received from donations or from an event shall be devoted to said purpose listed in the mission statement:

West Volusia Friends of Felines, Inc. is a non profit support coalition to improve the lives of feral and homeless cats living in West Volusia County. The mission is to reduce the numbers of the unwanted and abandoned felines through trap—neuter—return (TNR) programs. The "no-kill" alliance with the felines is a voice communicated to the community of West Volusia, Florida from voices that can not speak for themselves. The program is an alternative to euthanasia and assistance to the local kill and non kill shelters in the county. Friends of Felines reaches out to the entire colony with TNR implemented, followed by the feral(s) re-released back into familiar surroundings. When the males and females are sterilized, the ferals are less likely to continue fighting, spraying, having unwanted kittens, and allowing additional intact cats from entering the colony. The agenda humanitarianly administers TNR, plus vaccinations. The future will then hold healthy cats and fewer cats per colony throughout the county.

### ARTICLE III LIMITATIONS

1. No part of the donations or event earnings of the corporation shall inure to any member of the corporation except to solely reimburse for services to the feral cats regarding veterinary examinations and/or surgery for reasonable allowance for authorized expenditures incurred on behalf of the corporation.

- 2. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall constitute the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, or any initiative or referendum before the public, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.
- 3. The corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted by the corporation articles as listed in the federal income tax under Section 501 I (3) of the Internal Revenue Code (Instructions for Form 1023, Rev. June, 2006 on file).
- 4. The corporation shall not lend any of its assets to any volunteer of this corporation or guarantee to any person the payment of a loan by an officer of this corporation.

### ARTICLE IV Volunteers

West Volusia Friends of Felines, Inc. is an organization with a small group of volunteers that manages the affairs of the coalition. Titles were appointed to three volunteer members, i.e. President, Joyce Fulton; Vice President, Morris Culpepper; and Secretary/Treasurer, Adrienne Baker. All the volunteer members have voting rights and we are not under any Board of Directors.

## ARTICLE V Debt Obligations and Personal Liability Limited Liability Company

No member of this corporation shall be personally liable for the debts or obligations of this corporation of any nature whatsoever, nor shall any of the property of the members be subject to the payment of the debts or obligation of this corporation. Any volunteermember that is handling or trapping a feral cat will do so at their own risk; any injury occurred will also be at the volunteer's expense.

#### ARTICLE VI Dissolution

Upon the dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the feral government, or to a state of local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purpose.
