Be it know that I, Gerald V. Foster, aka, 'Jersey Jerry', do hereby affirm that to the best of my knowledge the answers I am about to give in the attached Interrogatories about Pirates on the Panhandle, Inc. are true and that I have answered them to the best of my ability, so help me God!

To better understand the reason for forming Pirates on the Panhandle, Inc. I feel it necessary to explain a little background about how and why we are at this point.

On May 22, 2009, Parrot Heads in Paradise, Inc. (hereinafter referred to as PHiP), awarded Gerald V. Foster and Lackey Ray White (Co-founders of Pirates on the Panhandle, a Parrot Head Club from Navarre Beach, Florida) the opportunity to establish a Parrot Head Club in the Navarre / Navarre Beach, Florida area (please note email from PHiP Bob Heffelfinger, Director of Membership for PHiP welcoming Pirates on the Panhandle as a sanctioned chapter of PHiP and marked as Exhibit "1"). PHiP is an international corporation established in 1989 as a Not-For-Profit Corporation that follows the life-style of Jimmy Buffett and his music with over 200 Parrot Head Clubs in the United States, Canada, Australia and the Caribbean Islands, whose purpose is to assist within the local community with charitable activities as each Parrot Head Clubs gives back to their communities. The motto of Parrot Head Clubs is "Party With A Purpose!" and PHiP holds the trademark to the phrase 'Parrot Heads' and in order to form a Parrot Head Club you need to receive PHiP's approval.

Well, upon receiving a Charter from PHiP allowing the formation of a Parrot Head Club in the Navarre / Navarre Beach area. Mr.

Foster filed documents with the State of Florida and Pirates on the Panhandle, Inc. was established as a Florida State Not-For-Profit corporation on June 1, 2009 (please note attached copies of those documents marked Exhibit "2").

Over the $2\frac{1}{2}$ years that Mr. Foster was President the Parrot Head Club was able to maintain its Charter w/PHiP (please note attached copies from PHiP showing that Pirates on the Panhandle was 'A Sanctioned Chapter in Good Standing' during Mr. Foster's term as President; i.e., May '09 to December '11 and marked as Exhibit "3"), and at one time had 258 paid members and was the eleventh largest Parrot Head Club in the world. Also during those $2\frac{1}{2}$ years, the Pirates on the Panhandle Parrot Head Club raised over 28 thousand dollars for local and national charities and contributed over 2,200 man-hour of community service under Mr. Foster's leadership.

On January 1, 2012 Mr. Foster stepped down as President of the Parrot Head Club and Ms. Lea Shaw was President during the 2012 calendar year and a new Board of Directors took control of the Parrot Head Club (please note attached copies of the Annual Reports from '10 to '12 showing Officers and Directors for each year and marked as Exhibit "4"). During Ms. Shaw's presidency she did several things that the membership disapprotved of including taking it upon herself to cancel the Adopt-A-Highway project, cancelling membership in the Navarre Beach Area Chamber of Commerce, holding secret BOD meetings at her home, to name a few, and then in August 2012 she tried to change the name of the Club to either Navarre Frutcakes Parrot Head Club or Navarre Day Dreamin' Parrot Head Club. So it was NO surprise that a lot of

members stopped attending events and most socials had less than 15 members attending and the Club lot over 200 members when it came time to renew membership in October 2012 when only about 30 members renewed.

Unfortunately, on December 31, 2012, at 8:35pm, PHiP sent an email to Ms. Shaw notifying her that the Pirates on the Panhandle Parrot Head Club's Charter would NOT be renewed. The PHiP attorney responsible for managing "Club Charters" directed Ms. Shaw to dissolve the Pirates on the Panhandle Parrot Head Club (NOT the Pirates on the Panhandle corporation) stating in his judgment ... 'Ms. Shaw - As the senior officer, it is your responsibility to see that the chapter is liquidated in accordance with established PHiP policy and to advise this office when the task is completed. Any and all funds remaining in the Club treasury must be donated to a local charity as determined by the sitting Board and the bank account subsequently closed.' ... (please note attached email dated Monday, 31 Dec 2012 and sent at 20:35 hours, i.e., 8:35pm, on New Year's Eve from PHiP's Director of Membership notifying Ms. Shaw that PHiP would NOT renew the charter and marked as Exhibit "5").

Ms. Shaw's task from PHiP was to dissolve the Parrot Head Club and liquidated its assets; however, she also took it upon herself to forward to the State of Florida Articles of Dissolution stating that ... 'The date of the meeting of members at which the resolution to dissolve was adopted 31 Dec. 2012. The number of votes cast by the members was sufficient for approval.' ... (please note attached Articles filed by Ms. Shaw on January 11, 2013 and marked as Exhibit "6"). However, there was NO membership meeting on New

Year's Eve as she stated on the Articles of Dissolution and thus NO votes could have been cast to dissolve the corporation. Shaw sent the form to the state to dissolve Pirates on the Panhandle, Inc. corporation WITHOUT input from or notification to the membership and dissolved the corporation based ONLY on PHiP not renewing the Parrot Head Club's charter even though current members along with former members who did not renew their membership to the Parrot Head Club wanted to continue Pirates on the Panhandle, Inc. as a Social Club so that they could continue within activities charitable the Navarre doina community. Therefore, there is NO LIST of authorized members that voted in favor of the dissolution of the Pirates on the Panhandle, Inc. corporation.

On Saturday, February 23, 2013, as small group of former members gathered to see if it would be possible to continue our charitable work within the community as a Social Club and NOT a Parrot Head Club (please note the attached list of the Leadership Team under Interrogatories #2 and marked as Exhibit "B"). It was determined that there were at a minimum 50 folks that would re-join if we were able to re-activate Pirates on the Panhandle, Inc. and so we voted to move forward and we made arrangements to hold a meeting at the Navarre Elks Club on Saturday afternoon, March 2, 2013 to determine the level of interest from others.

On Monday, February 25, 2013, Mr. Foster called the 800 number listed on the State's website and spoke with someone and explained what happened to the Pirates on the Panhandle, Inc. corporation (as noted above) and was put on hold (for what seemed like 10 minutes) and upon her return the lady stated that Pirates on the

Panhandle, Inc. was a Florida State Not-For-Profit Corporation and NO WHERE did it state anything at all about being a Parrot Head Club and that if we wanted to re-activate the corporation we had 180 days from January 11, 2013 to do so and all we had to do was hold a meeting of former members; vote new officers; fill out the State Form; and forward a check in the amount of \$35 (please note attached documents forwarded March 4, 2013 along w/a copy of the cancelled check and marked as Exhibit "7").

On Saturday, March 2, 2013 a membership meeting took place at the Navarre Elks Club as we started to re-form the Pirates on the Panhandle as a Social Club (please note the attached list of 61 current members as of June 13, 2013 under Interrogatories #1 and marked as Exhibit "A").

As a testimony to renewing the Pirates on the Panhandle as a Social Club there are 61 paid members as of June 13, 2013 which is more than were on the membership rolls as of December 31, 2012 when PHiP did NOT renew the Pirates on the Panhandle Parrot Head Club's Charter. By the actions of our current members so far we have begun the charitable activities once again within our community and at the April social just 16 members donated 394 pounds of dog food to our local animal shelter. This in itself shows how much a few folks can do to assist those less fortunate than ourselves.

In closing I feel that our Pirates on the Panhandle, Inc. corporation is an active Social Club doing some great things within our community and as you can see from the attached Exhibit "8" we are current with ALL information and fees as I understand.

Again, I make this statement to the best of my knowledge and ability.

I checked on the piratesonthepanhandle.com website, and it expires on June 9th of this year. It is registered to a Ms. Lea Shaw through Godaddy.com. She will be given the opportunity to renew it prior to it's expiration, which is not very expensive to do. Knowing Lea, she might renew it just to keep us from getting it once she knows that we are reforming the club. There are ways to try to buy it before it expires (at a premium), and then the issue would be what would Lea do with the money? We could go ahead and get piratesonthepanhandle.net and/or piratesonthepanhandle.org, which are both available now for around \$25-30 for 3 years, and then bid on the ".com" address if it becomes available after June 9. Pirates-On-The-Panhandle.com (with the dashes in the address) is also available, but that is kind of clunky to type in my opinion. There are also website builders offered by Godaddy and other sites that make it really easy to design the website directly from their site. We don't really have to do anything yet on this, but it may be worth considering to lock in the .net or .org address as soon as possible while they are available, and as soon as we know for sure that we can still keep Pirates on the Panhandle as a corporate name.


