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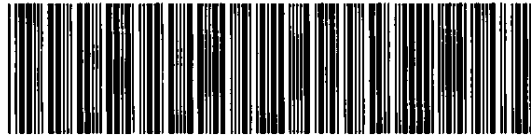

Pursuant to the provisions of section 617.1006, Florida Statutes, this **Florida Not For Profit Corporation** adopts the following amendment(s) to its Articles of Incorporation:

Change Article III to read:

The purpose for which this corporation is organized is

- To provide activities to improve education through the use of robotics and technology
- To encourage students to study science, technology, engineering and math by engaging them in robotics and technology activities
- To conduct robotic and other science related activities for educators and students in the state of Florida, including but not limited to competitions and training
- To award scholarships to outstanding Florida students who have been active in robotics and pursuing a technology degree.

Add Article VIII to read:

Article VIII Period

The term for which it is organized shall be perpetual.

Add Article IX to read:


Article IX Dissolution

Upon dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more educational purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax to be selected by the board of directors.
