ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

In Compliance with Chapter 617, F.S., (Not for Profit)

ARTICLE I: NAME

The name of the corporation shall be Florida Integrity Training Inc.

ARTICLE II: PRINCIPAL OFFICE

ARTICLE III: PURPOSE

Said corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

The Corporation's purpose is to teach life skills through faith with a focus on the homeless, destitute, offenders, ex-offenders and their families. This will begin with a published 100-hour curriculum and leader training sessions to make volunteers effective in working with these groups. The Corporation shall network with Christian churches, penal institutions, halfway houses, and social agencies to facilitate successful transitioning from addiction or incarceration to productive citizenship and personal quality of life.

As resources permit, the Corporation may further its purpose by opening halfway houses for offenders, residential centers for registered sex offenders, and community-based educational programs. All of this will be done with educational programs that integrate basic life skills with Christian living.

The corporation will forever emphasize the small-group format and the training of leaders in this format as the basis for its educational and spiritual programs.
