ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

Single Parent Assistance, Resources & Knowledge Network, Inc. In Compliance with Chapter 617, F.S., A Florida (Not for Profit)

The undersigned, acting as incorporator of a Single Parent Assistance, Resources & Knowledge Network, Inc. under Chapter 617 of Florida Statutes, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the corporation shall be Single Parent Assistance, Resources & Knowledge Network, Inc.

ARTICLE II PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The street address of the initial principal office of the corporation is 6251 Phillips Highway Suite 1, Jacksonville, FL 32216

ARTICLE III MAILING OFFICE

The street address and mailing office of the corporation is: 4116 Ringneck Drive, Jacksonville, FL 32226

ARTICLE IV PURPOSE

The corporation is organized as a corporation not for profit, exclusively for charitable, religious, educational and scientific purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, including but not limited to providing single parents (never married, divorced, widowed, married and separated) Assistance (financial scholarships, student loan payment assistance, daycare funding, automobile assistance, birthday funds, vacation subsidies, child support attorney assistance, home down payment assistance and 1st year maintenance, etc.), Resources (collaboration with non-profit organizations, clothing assistance, working with homebuilder organizations to build an affordable rental neighborhood for Single Parent housing, mentorship opportunities for the children and parents, college and trade schools, etc.) and Knowledge (creating life strategy plans, parenting seminars, daily tips, budgeting, financial education, home buyer education, college and career classes, etc.) for Single Parent Families in the form of face-to-face meetings, SYNERGY conference calls and webinars to empower the parent and child with information to assist them in their daily challenges of raising children and living in a single parent home by activating confidence and inspiring wisdom in the single parent family to create an environment where children are happy, healthy, safe, loved and assist parent's with achieving parenting success by teaching the principles of the "10 Commandments of the Successful Single Parent".

1. To aid, support, and assist by gifts, contributions, or otherwise, other corporations, community chests, funds and foundations organized and operated exclusively for charitable or educational purposes, no part of the net earnings of which inures to the benefit of any private shareholder or individual, and no substantial part of



the activities of which is carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation.

- 2. To do any and all lawful activities which may be necessary, useful, or desirable for the furtherance, accomplishment, fostering, or attaining of the foregoing purposes, either directly or indirectly, and either alone or in conjunction or cooperation with others, whether such others be persons or organizations of any kind or nature, such as corporations, firms, association, trusts, institution, foundations, or governmental bureaus, departments or agencies.
- 3. All of the foregoing purposes shall be exercised exclusively charitable and educational purposes in such a manner that the Corporation will qualify as an exempt organization under section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

ARTICLE V MANNER OF ELECTION:

The method of selection of the Board of Directors and number of directors shall be stated in the bylaws.

ARTICLE VI INITIAL BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The method of selection of the Board of Directors and number of directors shall be bylaws. No initial Board of Directors at this time.

ARTICLE VII INITIAL REGISTERED AGENT AND STREET ADDRES

The name of the registered agent of the corporation is Montina L. Fortune. The address registered agent is 4116 Ringneck Drive, Jacksonville, FL 32226.

ARTICLE VIII INCORPORATOR

The name and address of the incorporator is: Montina L. Fortune, 4116 Ringneck Drive, Jacksonville, FL 32226.

ARTICLE IX DURATION AND COMMENCEMENT

The corporation will exist perpetually, commencing on the date of filing of these Article of Incorporation.

ARTICLE X MEMBERS

The qualification for members, if any, and the manner of their admission shall be regulated by the bylaws.

ARTICLE XI LIMITATIONS ON CORPORATE POWER

1. CORPORATE PURPOSES: Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal and state income tax under section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or the corresponding provision of any future

United States Internal Revenue law.

- **2. EXCLUSIVITY:** The Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes.
- 3. NO PRIVATE INUREMENT: The Corporation is not organized nor shall it be operated for the primary purpose of generating pecuniary gain or profit. The Corporation shall not distribute any gains, profits or dividends to the Directors, Officers, or Members thereof, or to any individual, except as reasonable compensation for services actually performed in carrying out the Corporation's charitable and educational purposes. The property, assets, profits and net income of the Corporation are irrevocably dedicated to charitable and educational purposes no part of which shall inure to the benefit of any individual.
- 4. LOBBYING AND POLITICAL CAMPAIGNS: No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall consist of the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in, any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

ARTICLE XII DISSOLUTION:

Upon winding up and dissolution of the Corporation, the assets of the Corporation remaining after payment of all debts and liabilities shall be distributed to an organization recognized as exempt under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to be used exclusively for charitable and educational purposes. If the Corporation holds any assets in trust, such assets shall be disposed of in such a manner as may be directed by decree of the Circuit Court of the district in which the Corporation's principal office is located, upon petition thereof by the Attorney General or by any person concerned in the liquidation.

ARTICLE XIII INDEMNIFICATION

The corporation shall indemnify any person who is or was a party to any proceeding by reason of the fact that such person is or was a director or officer of the corporation or of any corporation not for profit of which the corporation is a member, to the fullest extent not prohibited by law, for actions taken in the capacity of such person as a director or officer of the corporation or of any corporation not for profit of which the corporation is a member. To the fullest extent not prohibited by law, the corporation shall advance indemnification expenses for actions taken in the capacity of such person as an officer or director, within twenty (20) days after receipt by the corporation of (1) a written statement requesting such advance, (2) evidence of the expenses incurred, and (3) a written statement by or on behalf of such person agreeing to repay the advanced expenses if it is ultimately determined that such a person is not entitled to be indemnified against such expenses.

ARTICLE XIV AMMENDMENT

The Corporation reserves the right to amend, add to, or repeal any provisions contains in these articles of Incorporation in the manner consistent with the law and in conformi with the provision set forth in the bylaws.
