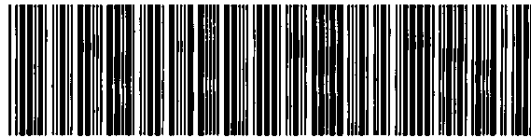

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
OF

ARTICLE I

PURPOSE AND NAME: The undersigned, for the purposes of forming a not-for-profit corporation under the Florida Not-for-Profit Corporation Act, Florida Statutes, Chapter 617, hereby adopts these Articles of Incorporation. The name of the Corporation shall be: RETROUVAILLE OF TAMPA BAY INC.

ARTICLE II

PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS: 12100 Seminole Blvd. Lot 349, Largo, FL 33778.

ARTICLE III

CHARITABLE PURPOSE: The purpose for which this Corporation is organized is the transaction of any or all lawful business for which nonprofit corporations may engage in under the Laws of the State of Florida, as they may be amended from time to time, and as may be permitted under Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended.

ARTICLE IV

INITIAL BUSINESS: Said Corporation is organized exclusively for offering a Christian experience to alleviate marriage breakdown and other religious and education purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, including for such purpose the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Laws).

ARTICLE V

DISTRIBUTION OF FUNDS: No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article IV. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of any other provision of these Articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on: (1) by a corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal

Revenue Section Code of 1986, (or corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) or:(2) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170 (c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, (or the corresponding provisions of any future United State Internal Revenue Laws).

#### ARTICLE VI

DISSOLUTION: Upon the dissolution of the Corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provisions for the payment of all the liabilities of the Corporation, dispose of all of its assets exclusively for the purposes of the Corporation in such manner, or to such organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, education, religious or scientific purpose as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501(c)(3)of the Internal Revenue Section Code of 1986,(or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Laws) as the Board of Directors shall determine. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by the Circuit Court of the County in which the principal office of the Corporation is then located, exclusively for such purpose or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purpose.

#### ARTICLE VII

INDEMNIFICATION: The power of indemnification under the Florida Statues shall not be denied or limited by the Bylaws.

#### ARTICLE VIII

ANNUAL MEETING: The annual meeting is to be held at a place within or without the State as fixed by the Bylaws.

#### ARTICLE IX

##### ADMINISTRATION:

1. The power to alter, amend, or repeal the Bylaws or adopt new Bylaws, subject to repeal or change by the action of the members, shall be vested and reserved to the Board of Directors.
2. In addition to the Statutory Provisions under Florida Law, a special meeting may be called by:
  - (A) The Spiritual Director, or;
  - (B) Any two members of the Board of Directors, or;
  - (C) In accordance with any provision in the Bylaws.
3. The right of members or classes of members, to vote may be limited, enlarged or denied to the extent provided in the Bylaws if such provision is approved

and adopted by a majority of the membership at a reasonable time prior to any specific vote.

4. Subject to the limitations under Florida Law, the Bylaws shall fix the number of Directors, the manner of election, and term of office.
5. A Director may not be removed from office except upon the establishment of misfeasance, malfeasance, or nonfeasance, as determined by a seventy-five percent (75%) majority vote of the Directors.

#### ARTICLE X

BOARD OF DIRECTORS: There shall be no fewer than three (3) nor more than fifteen (15) Directors. The names and addresses of the persons who are to serve as Directors until the first annual meeting of the Directors or until their successors are elected and qualified are:
