

VIII.

With respect to claims or liabilities arising out of service as a director or officer of the Corporation, the Corporation shall indemnify and advance expenses to each present and future director (and his or her estate, heirs and personal representatives) to the fullest extent allowed by the laws of the state of Florida, as may hereafter be adopted or amended.

The purpose for which the Corporation is organized is: to operate exclusively for charitable and religious purposes within the meaning of section 501c3 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or corresponding section of any future Federal Tax Code; and generally to engage in any other lawful endeavor or activity in furtherance of any of the foregoing purposes.





Notwithstanding, any other provision of the articles of Incorporation, the Corporation shall not carry on any endeavors or activities not permitted to be carried on by a Corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under section 501c3 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or corresponding section of any future Federal Tax Code, or by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170c2 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or corresponding section of any future Federal Tax Code.


