# Attachment to Articles of incorporation of Hibiscus Masonic Review. Inc.

This corporation is organized exclusively for one or more of the purposes as specified in section 501 (C) (3) of the internal revenue code, including for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under sections 501 (C) (3) of the internal revenue code. This corporation shall be a nonprofit corporation. The specific purpose for which this corporation is organized is the author/self—publisher of Masonic books; this Masonic Review will help those in need through education of Masonic Education

Upon the dissolution of this corporation, its assets remaining after payment or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of this corporation shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501 (C)(3) of the internal revenue code or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to the state or local government for public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction of the country in which the principal office of the corporation is located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations as said court shall determine which are organized and operated exclusively for such purpose.

No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or other wise attempting to influence legislation (exempt as other wise provide by section 501 (h) of the internal revenue code), and this corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in, (including the publishing or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office.

No part of the net earnings of this corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, directors, officers, or other private persons except that this corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purpose set forth in these articles.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c) (2) of the internal revenue code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

All reference to sections of the internal revenue code shall include such sections as of the data hereof and the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
