ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF WORLD FIREFIGHTER RACQUETBALL ASSOCIATION, INC.

By these Articles of Incorporation the incorporators hereby form a Corporation not-for-profit under the laws of the State of Florida, pursuant to Florida Statutes 617.

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the Corporation is: World Firefighter Racquetball Association, Inc.

ARTICLE II ADDRESS

The street address of the principal office of the Corporation is:

ARTICLE III PURPOSE

The specific purpose for which the Corporation is organized is:

to increase awareness of racquetball worldwide to all Firefighters and Emergency Medical Services (EMS) personnel through fund-raisers, shootouts, State, Regional, National and World Tournaments. World Firefighter Racquetball Association (WFRA) is committed to promoting health, wellness, camaraderie, sportsmanship, friendship, safety and competitiveness through competition for all Firefighters and EMS Personnel worldwide through racquetball. WFRA is also committed to helping Firefighter and EMS charities, Firefighter and EMS families in need, and also to assist aspiring Firefighter and EMS Personnel to help them attain an educational goal in the career of Firefighting and EMS. WFRA is committed to partnering with agencies or organizations to try and lower the risk of Heart Disease, which is the leading cause of death among Firefighter and EMS personnel.

ARTICLE IV STOCK

This Corporation shall issue no shares of stock of any kind or nature whatsoever. There shall be no dividends paid to any of the members, nor shall any part of the income of the Corporation be distributed to it's Officers or Trustees.

ARTICLE V REGISTERED AGENT

ARTICLE VI CORPORATION NOT-FOR-PROFIT

No part of the net earnings of this corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its members, directors, officers or other private persons except that this corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in this article. No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation. This corporation shall not participate or intervene in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office, including the publishing or distribution of statements. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law, or by corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Code. On the dissolution of this corporation the board of Directors shall dispose of all the assets of this corporation exclusively for the purposes of this corporation to an organization organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious or scientific purposes and that qualifies as exempt organizations under Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law, after paying or making provisions for the payment of all liabilities of this corporation. Any assets not disposed of shall be distributed to the Federal government, or to a State or local government, for a public purpose, and none of the assets will be distributed to any member, Officer or Director of this corporation.

ARTICLE VII BOARD OF DIRECTORS
