## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF HONEST AID, INC.

(A Corporation Not For Profit)

We, the undersigned residents of the State of Florida, being eighteen (18) or more years of age, do herby associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a Corporation Not for Profit, under the laws of the State of Florida, Pursuant to the following Articles of Incorporation:

#### Article I - Name

The name of the Corporation is HONEST AID, INC.

#### Article II – PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The mailing and street address of the principal office of the Corporation is 1485 Holly Avenue, Merritt Island, Florida 32952.

#### ARTICLE III - STATEMENT OF CORPORATE NATURE

The Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, educational, religious or scientific purposes within the meaning of section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code).

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article II hereof.

No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

Notwithstanding any other provision of the articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, of (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or by the corresponding section of any future federal tax code

**ARTICLE IV- DURATION**

The period of duration of this Corporation Not for Profit shall be perpetual.

#### ARTICLE V – GENERAL AND SPECIFIC PURPOSES

The Specific and primary purpose for which this Corporation is formed is to create opportunity, hope, and an improved quality of life for people in every country in which the Corporation operates.

#### ARTICLE VI – INITAIL DIRECTORS AND OFFICERS

The initial board of directors shall consist of four (4) members. This number may be increased or decreased from time to time in accordance with the Corporation's bylaws, but shall never be less than one. The names, titles, and addresses of the persons who will serve on the initial board of directors are:

#### ARTICLE VII - MANNER OF ELECTION

Directors are to be elected by a majority vote in accordance with the bylaws of the Corporation.

#### ARTICLE VIII - BYLAWS

The bylaws of this Corporation shall be approved by a majority vote of the Board of Directors. The bylaws may be amended or rescinded in the same manner.

#### ARTICLE IX - AMENDMENT TO ARTICLES

The Articles of Incorporation may be amended by a majority vote of the Board of Directors.

#### ARTICLE X – DISSOLUTION

Upon the dissolution of the Corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the Corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

### ARTICLE XI – INITIAL REGISTERED AGENT AND STEET ADDRESS

The initial street address of the Corporation's registered office is 1485 Holly Avenue. Merritt Island, Florida 32952. The initial registered agent at that address is Wan Mosrie.

#### ARTICLE XII - INCORPORATION

The Corporation shall indemnify its directors, officers, employees, and agents to the fullest extent permitted by law.
