ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

COLUMBIA CHEER ASSOCIATION, INC.

(a corporation not for profit)

ARTICLE I

This is a non-profit corporation organized for the purposes set forth herein pursuant to and under the provisions of Chapter 617, Florida Statutes.

ARTICLE II

The name of this corporation is **COLUMBIA CHEER ASSOCIATION**, INC.

ARTICLE III

The corporation is organized and shall be operated exclusively as a nonstock charitable organization for the purpose of teaching the basic fundamentals of cheerleading and to provide an opportunity to cheer in a safe manner while developing qualities of sportsmanship, teamwork, self confidence, poise, and community. The Corporation is also a support group for the Columbia County, Florida Recreation Department. Further, the corporation is organized and shall be operated to have and to exercise to the extent necessary or desirable for the accomplishment of the aforesaid purposes; and to the extent that said purposes are not inconsistent with the charitable purposes of the corporation, and all powers conferred upon non-profit corporations by the laws of the State of Florida.



ARTICLE IV

This corporation is to begin its existence upon the date and time of the filing of the Articles of Incorporation with the Department of State, and shall thereafter exist perpetually.

ARTICLE V

The qualifications for membership of this corporation and the manner of their admission shall be governed and regulated by the By-Laws of this corporation.

ARTICLE VI

The street address of the initial registered office and the principal office of the corporation is 9732 NW Lake Jeffrey Road, Lake City, Florida 32055, and the name of its initial registered agent at such address is **WILDA DRAWDY**.

ARTICLE VII

Section 1: The business affairs of this corporation shall be managed by its officers, Board of Directors and members. This corporation shall initially have five (5) directors. The number of directors may be decreased or increased from time to time by the By-Laws of the corporation, but shall never be less than five (5).

Section 2: The Officers and Board of Directors shall be members of the corporation.

Section 3: Officers and members of the Board of Directors shall be elected and hold office in accordance with the By-Laws.

ARTICLE VIII

Section 1: The corporation may exercise all the powers which are now or hereafter conferred by law upon corporations not organized for pecuniary gain or profit, or necessary or incidental to the powers so conferred, or conducive to the attainment of the purposes of the corporation, subject to such limitations as are or may be prescribed by law, and subject specifically to the following restrictions. Notwithstanding any other provisions of this Charter, no substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation; and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. The corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

Section 2: Should the corporation be dissolved, by the expiration of its Charter or otherwise, then all assets owned by the corporation shall be distributed to such corporations or organizations as would then qualify for exemption from Federal Income Tax under the provisions of Section 50l(c)(3) of the Internal revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

Section 2: Amendments may also be made at a regular meeting of the membership upon notice given, as provided by the By-Laws, of intention to submit such amendments.

Section 3: No amendment may be made affecting the provisions of Article VIII.
