#### ARTICLE III

The purpose of Treasure Coast Community Coalition, Inc., is to spearhead initiatives designed to effectively educate and train local community organizations in the Treasure Coast area (Indian River, Martin, Okeechobee and St. Lucie Counties, Florida) to:

- Identify and address key issues affecting the Treasure Coast;
- Develop strategies and effectively communicate them to the Treasure Coast Community;
- Develop and strengthen their skills, abilities and processes;
- Collate identified issues and disseminate to local stakeholders;
- Collaborate with local agencies to identify joint strategies that would improve services to the community.

Said corporation is organized to receive and administer funds and operates exclusively for charitable and educational purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

#### **ARTICLE IV**

#### Manner of Election

The initial Directors are appointed by the incorporators. The nominating committee, annually, shall present a slate of nominees for officers on the board of directors. Nominations shall be accepted from the floor for all positions eligible. Directors shall be elected by the affirmative vote of a majority of the Membership at its annual meeting. Vacancies occurring in the Board of Directors by reason of death, resignation, removal or other inability to serve shall be filled by the affirmative vote of a majority of the remaining directors although less than a quorum of the Board of Directors. A director elected to fill a vacancy shall serve for the unexpired portion of the term. Directors shall be eligible for re-election. Directors shall be elected and installed at the June annual Membership meeting.

## **ARTICLE VIII**

# **Restriction on Operations**

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributed to its directors, officers, or other private persons, except

that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for service rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

### **ARTICLE IX**

Dissolution and Disposition of Corporate Assets

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as such court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
